
Why is it so important to detect COVID-19 cases and close contacts early?

/ Early detection of **people with COVID-19** and rapid identification and isolation of **close contacts** is essential to **cut transmission chains and avoid possible new outbreaks**.

/ Furthermore, this can be used to **follow up on symptoms** and to suggest **preventive isolation**, as well as to carry out **diagnostic tests** to detect possible **asymptomatic COVID-19 cases**.

What is a close contact?

/ Close contacts are people with whom space has been shared at a distance of less than 2 metres, for over 15 minutes, without wearing masks and over the course of the 48 hours prior to the beginning of symptoms.

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

What should I do if I have COVID-19 symptoms?

/ If you have a fever, cough or shortness of breath, general malaise, diarrhoea or vomiting, you should:

b get in touch with your primary care centre,



• or make an eQuery through

La meva /Salut

/Your general practitioner will assess your symptoms and, if required, will carry out a diagnostic test.



/You can check your results on La Meva Salut.

What should I do if I am 4 a suspected case?

- If you are a suspected case, you should identify the people you have been in contact with over the 48 hours prior to the beginning of symptoms or carrying out the test.
- You can do so using the Gestor/a COVID or by using the ContacteCovid.cat keys that will be sent to you via SMS.



/ If you test **positive for COVID-19**, you will be notified via your **health centre**. Youwill also receive an **SMS** from **ContacteCovid.cat**, from where you can report your close contacts, follow up on symptoms, learn about how to self-isolate at home and request sick leave, if required.

/ Healthcare professionals will also provide you with follow-up and information.

/ The results for your tests will be available at La Meva Salut.




/ You must report your Close contacts through the COVID managers and/or through the

ContacteCovid.cat tool.

/You should **self-isolate at home** as per the healthcare professionals' instructions. You will be provided with information on how to do so.



/You should follow up on and monitor your symptoms twice a day through the STOP COVID19 app. If you cannot use the app, you should take your temperature twice a day.



/ If you **need to requestsick** leave, you can do so through an eConsultation at La Meva Salut.

What happen if I



/ You will be notified that you are a **close contact** of someone with COVID-19 via a **phone call** and an **SMS** from the ContacteCovid.cat tool.

Vou should preventively selfisolate for 10 days after contact with the diagnosed case, regardless of whether you are positive or negative.



We will get in touch with you to schedule a diagnostic test.

/ You should follow up on your symptoms through the STOP COVID19 CAT app twice a day.



If you have any symptoms, you should:

get in touch with your primary care centre,





/ If you are working and cannot do so from home, You will receive information on how to request sick leave.

If you have not displayed any symptoms by the end of your self-isolation, your healthcare professional will tell you when you can return to your normal lifestyle.





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
