Isolation

for close contacts and positive COVID-19 cases



What should I do if I'm a close contact or positive case?

/ Isolate in a single bedroom.

/ Try not to leave the room and, if you absolutely must, both you and the people living with you should always wear a mask.



/ Wash your hands often with soap and water or hand sanitizer, especially after coughing sneezing and touching objects or sufaces.





/ Wash your clothes separate from the rest and at 60° or more.

/ Clean the bathroom after each use if you do not have a separate bathroom for yourself.

It is important that you remain reachable.

/ Follow up and monitor your symptoms twice a day through the STOP COVID19 CAT app.

/ Air out the room thoroughly (for 10 minutes, 3 times a day).





When will I know my results if I undergo a diagnostic test?

/ If you have been tested for COVID-19, you can check your test results through La Meva Salud within 48-72 hours after the sample was taken.

/ If the test was a rapid antibody test, you will get your results in 20 minutes at the testing location.

/ If you still don't have access to La Meva Salut, you can register through the form below:



What should I do if my test results are negative?

/ If your diagnostic test is negative, you should still undergo preventive isolation for 10 days as this is the longest incubation period for the virus.

/ Monitor your symptoms and, if any appear, get in touch with your GP through the La Meva Salut eConsultation.

If your symptoms are severe, call 061 directly.





What should I do if my test results are positive?

/ If your diagnostic test is positive, you must remain in home isolation.
