

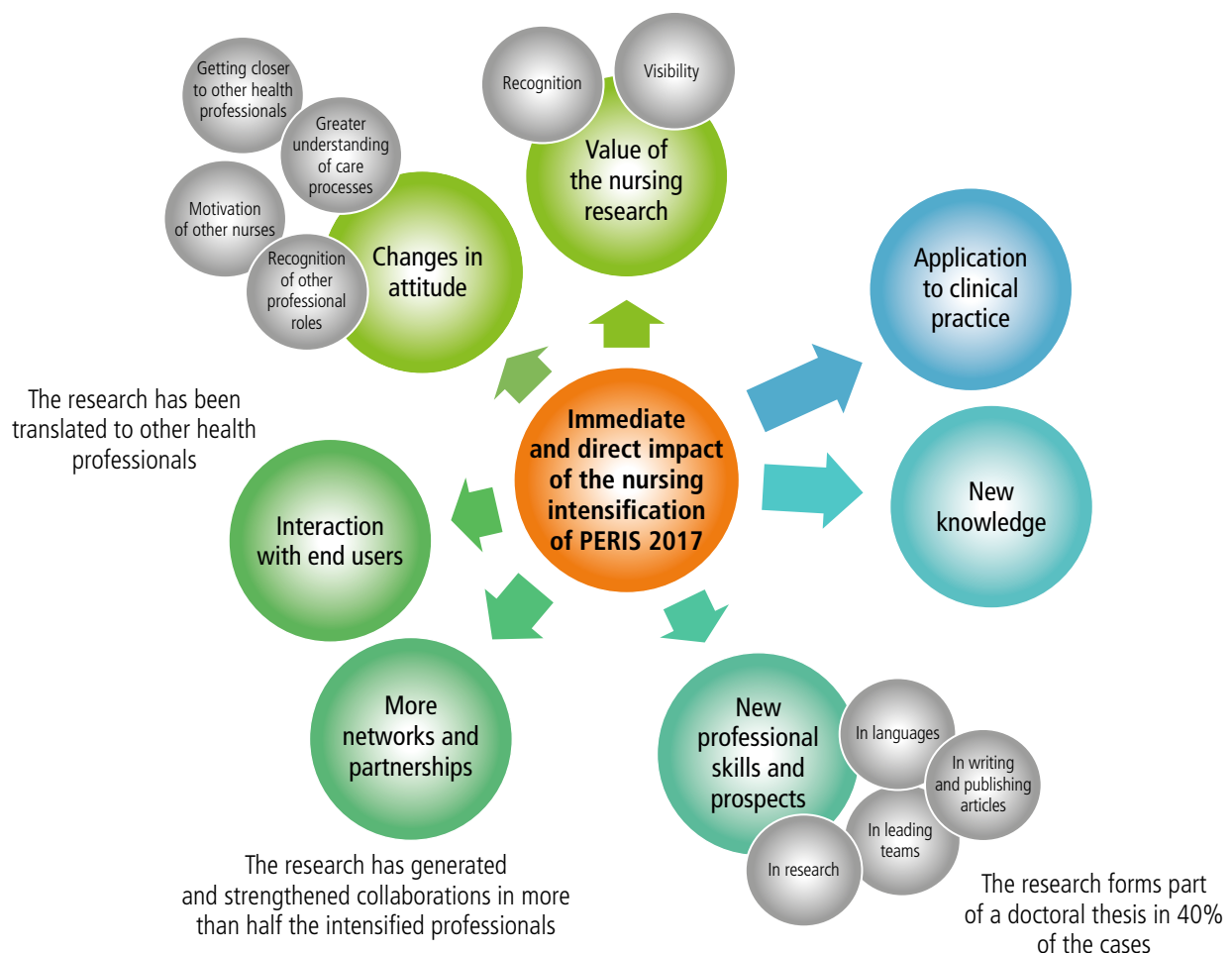
SUMMARY OF SARIS MONOGRAPH SERIES ON TRANSFORMATIVE RESEARCH

How did the first PERIS funding scheme for nursing research go?

In 2017, for the first time, the PERIS research funding programme has promoted releasing nursing professionals from care work to carry out research activities for a maximum period of nine months. SARIS monograph no. 4 systemically analyses both the opportunities and barriers that the PERIS 2017 call has provided to professionals, as well as the benefits for the health system. This was done by analysing the text of the Research Snapshots ('Instantànies de Recerca'), forms that the beneficiaries of the grants filled out at the end of the period on their experience, their research, their findings and the benefits achieved.

The opportunities for 61 intensified professionals translated into benefits for the system can be summarised as: the generation of diverse and heterogeneous knowledge that has impacted on both the care and research sectors, generating value; recognition and visibility for nursing research the influence that professionals' attitudes have on their environment, strengthening professional relationships and partnerships; the creation of new formal competences (doctoral theses) and informal ones; interactions with knowledge users (whether they are professionals or other researchers); and, ultimately, the application of findings to care practices, health treatment and programmes.
